

Dr. Dalia Kaies is an Assistant Professor of Economics at Helwan University and currently is currently in a temporary leave for being in a national mission as an academic staff member at Egypt-Japan University for Science and Technology (E-JUST) since 2022. She has also served as an adjunct assistant professor at various national universities and in international programs including; London School of Economics Program at the AAST (September 2021 – April 2022), Georgia Program at Cairo University (academic year 2021/2022) and the Russian University in Egypt (academic year 2021/2022) delivering lectures in Economics for both undergraduates and postgraduates.

Prior to being adjunct at E-JUST university, Dr. Dalia was the former Head of the Academic Mobility Division at the International Relations Office of Helwan University where she was responsible for the team collaborating with European Universities within the scheme of Erasmus+ KA171.
